Dear Ms. Beach,

This is my second attempt to make you aware of the Autistic Abuse I, and thus all other autistics, are suffering at the hand of your staff.

In 2009 The Autism Act was passed and two years later the documentation that ALL your staff have a LEGAL requirement to read was published.

Here I am, in the year 2025 and I am yet to find a single member of your staff whom even knows about the Law. Yet these people are making demands on me. Demands which are, at best, DISCRIMINATION and at worst HATE.

In October three members of your staff randomly turned up, expecting a meeting with me. I am pretty sure if I turned up at their offices and demanded the same I would be shown the door.

However, I was coerced into a meeting with the three of them. The important thing being that one of them was Sara Eden whom works in your autism team.

During that meeting everything I said was ignored. Instead, demand after demand was placed on me. The final one being that I would be evicted and have to live on the street, unless:

I, as an autistic person, could do the equivalent of of a blind person reading a book.

This was the only point that Eden spoke up on my behalf, only to stop and support the discrimination. Of course I made complaints after. Of course, everything was ignored.

Oh, I have the whole meeting recorded, by the way, capturing the discrimination. If you would like to hear for yourself what you staff consider acceptable behaviour:

I have even spoken to the Police about this matter and, for once, they were very clear:

I do not have to interact with anyone at the Council whom has not read the documentation that forms the Autism Act, 2009.

This means that if there is an unexpected ring of my bell, let alone a third time of letting themselves into the building only to knock on my door - I WILL IGNORE IT.

As Eden has ignored me asking for a replacement for her there is only one option left:

When you have someone trained in the Autism Act, have them text me

Until then, I am going to continue to focus on fixing my very serious health problems. As the Council refuse to offer me appropriate housing the only option I have is to stay here: WHERE I AM SAFE

No doubt none of what I have written above will make any difference. Therefore, on Monday, I now have no choice but to put my health in risk and abuse my ADHD meds to fix this problem. Have no doubt I will. In my old life I used to do amazing things.
