Dear Council,

I have been told by the police to make sure I have all complaints registered, even though previous complaints have just been ignored.

Therefore I need to make a complaint of, including but not limited to:

- Coercive Behaviour
- Discrimination
- Autistic Hate
- Omission and neglect as per The Care Act

This pattern was confirmed by forcing me to attend a meeting I only knew about when the council knocked on my door and demanded I attend, despite not sleeping for the past two days.

The addition of the autistic worker Sara Eden is yet another complaint, of what I have no idea. However, to use a person whom I described as the BEST autistic work I have met across 12 years and 3 County Councils, in such a situation is even more serious.

It shows, without any doubt, how Suffolk Council views Autistic people. I believe the expression is "wouldn't be bother to piss on if on fire".

And yes, as I am allowed to speak the way that I speak, I am going to be using the language that I use. Which means its okay for me to say "fuck this" in response to a question. It is not okay for me to say "fuck you".

Additionally, you where informed on the 18th November, by Suffolk Police, that I am right in that you are all supposed to have had Diversity Training on the Implementation of The Autism Act.

And that it is my Legal Right only to interact with people with such training. Of course I have heard nothing from the Council about this, and so that is a complaint as well.

As for the elderly couple Ive become so close with the connection is regarded as family? When I was helping them replace a faulty oven, I told them about the meeting I was coerhirst into attending. They both said a couple of things I couldn't process at the time. When I was back home I was able to. Both these people, nearer 90 than not, have chosen to learn about what it means to be autistic - just so they can understand me.

Yes, I cried. My own parents disowned me because they couldn't do this. Suffolk Council should be hung drawn and quartered - as not ONE of the people I have met, some 18 months ago could be bothered to do the same; even though they had a legal obligation to.

And so I stop. As next week I am dealing with the police, once I have the finished transcription of that meeting on the 17th.
